

Directions to Cranleigh Arts Centre

From Guildford by Car

- Follow signs for the A281 to Horsham.
- After passing through Shalford and Bramley, turn left onto the B2128 signposted to Cranleigh.
- After about one mile you will come to a roundabout, take the second turning towards Cranleigh.
- You will pass through Rowly, then reach another roundabout.
- Take the first exit into Cranleigh. This is the High Street.
- The Arts Centre is situated at the other end of the High Street, opposite an Esso garage and next to the church.
- There is a small car park at the rear of the building. Public car parks are available near by.

From Guildford by Public Transport

- The nearest station is Guildford (Waterloo to Portsmouth line).
- From Guildford you will need to get a bus to Cranleigh.
- The bus station is situated in the town centre about 5 minutes walk from the train station. From the train station, take the town centre exit, follow signs to the town centre, walking along Bridge Street. Cross at the traffic lights and walk through the Friary Shopping Centre, up one level. The exit comes out at the bus station.
- There are 3 buses per hour to Cranleigh (nos. 53 and 63).
- The journey takes approximately 25 minutes and there is a bus stop outside the Arts Centre.

Parking

There is limited parking behind the Arts Centre. We advise that customers use the Village Way car park by the leisure centre, as shown on the map, where parking is free after 6pm and is 3 minutes walk from the Centre.
