

“A Splash of Colour”
The Cranleigh Open Art Competition 2018
20th November to 15th December 2018

Cranleigh Arts Centre is delighted to announce the return of the popular Cranleigh Open Art Competition. Work in any traditional medium is acceptable (drawing, painting, printmaking, textiles and ceramics/sculpture). Digital art, photography and reproduction prints e.g. giclée will not be accepted. The winning artist and a runner up will win a shared exhibition during the summer of 2019.

Closing date for Entry:

All entry forms must be submitted to the Arts Centre by 4.30pm on Saturday 3rd November 2018 together with the submission fee which is non-refundable..

Submission and Selection:

Artists are able to submit a maximum of 3 artworks. A restriction on size will be 80cmX80cm to include the frame. All entries will be subject to a selection panel who's decision is final. Work not selected will be notified by email on Monday 19th November for collection on Tuesday 20th November.

By entering, artists agree that Cranleigh Arts Centre may use an image of their work for publicity purposes.

Delivery and Collection of Artwork

Delivery of artworks to the Arts Centre will be on Saturday 17th November between 1pm and 4pm only.

Collection of unsold work will be on Saturday 15th December between 3.30pm and 4.30pm.

Please ensure you keep your receipt to collect your work.

Preparing artwork for display

A luggage-style label showing the artist's name, title of artwork, medium, price must be securely attached to the back of the work.

All artworks which are to be wall-hung, must be appropriately framed and must have D-rings attached approximately 100mm (4 inches) from the top of the artwork, or proportionally-near the top for small artworks.

DAMAGED FRAMES OR DAMAGED OR WET ARTWORK WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

Fees and Charges:

There is a submission charge of £10 for up to 3 pieces and a commission fee of 30% + VAT on all sales will apply.

Cards and “Browser Work”

Cards and browser work are not accepted.

Sales and payment.

The Arts Centre will endeavour to process payments for sold artworks within 30 days of the exhibition closing.

Insurance

Exhibitors are responsible for insuring their own artwork. Cranleigh Arts Centre cannot be held responsible for damage, loss or theft of any artwork or possessions of the exhibitor.

Hanging and Display

The team at Cranleigh Arts Centre will be responsible for the hanging and display of all artworks in the exhibition.

Selection and Judging

Work will be assessed by two independent panels whose decisions are final. No discussion can be entered in to in relation to their decisions.

Preview

There will be a private view on Wednesday 21st November 2018 6pm to 8pm when the winner and runner up will be announced. The winner of the visitors vote will be announced separately at the end of the exhibition.

Publicity

Cranleigh Arts Centre will advertise the exhibition in as many ways as possible. The success of the exhibition and the future of the Gallery at Cranleigh Arts Centre rests on local artists spreading the word, and encouraging as many people as possible to come to the exhibitions.
